

SSAFA BRIEF TO KOSB AGM - 26 NOV 2022

SOME STATS

- 3400 volunteers –of whom 1300 are caseworkers.
- 16.000 cases and visits in 2021.
- Cases are well up, and beyond pre pandemic levels- 1200 in Scotland so far this year.
 Largest three Branches- around 150 each so far Fife, Lanarkshire and Edin/ Lothians, then G'gow/ Ayrshire. D & G 45, Borders -40+/-.
- £9 M + almonised from benevolent funds for clients already. F'cast to be £11M, cf £8.6M in 2021 . £1.5M in Scotland so far. Demand is huge, and growing.
- Calls to SSAFA Forcesline f'cast to be 130% up from pre pandemic levels. 0800 260 6767 or 0141 488 8552 for the Scottish equivalent.
- 80% of clients have long term physical or mental health issues

BIG ISSUES- social isolation, loneliness with impact on mental health, relationship breakdowns, family separations, leading to housing and debt problems, food and fuel / heating poverty.

SAFEGUARDING ISSUES well up. ie abuse/ violence ,sexual attacks , harming, suicide threats ,child neglect . 150 calls to the SSAA safeguarding office so far this year.

<u>Case Workers</u>- shortages all over UK. In Scotland 180 cases unallocated as at mid Nov. PLEASE - BORDERER VETERANS – give serious thought to becoming a SSAFA volunteer caseworker.
